



WORK INTEGRATED LEARNING PROGRAMME IN-SERVICE TRAINING 2023/24

Only shortlisted candidates will be required to submit relevant documents on or before the day of the interview. Applications received after the closing date will not be considered. Should you be in possession of a foreign qualification, and you are shortlisted for a position, you will be required to submit an evaluation certificate from the South African Qualifications Authority (SAQA) indicating the NQF level of the qualification. Failure to submit a fully completed signed Z83 and an updated CV will result in your application not being considered.
