KWACEZA PRAYER

KZN Sport, Arts and Culture MEC Dr Ntuthuko Mahlaba today pledged to refurbish some properties in KwaCeza in which fallen AmaZulu King Dinuzulu once fought some of the battles and where he also held a prayer during the tumultuous times of his reign. Mahlaba was part of today's umkhuleko waseNdlunkulu in which His Majesty King Misuzulu kaZwelithini delivered the main address.

Various church denominations came in their numbers. The King called for the removal of guns in the province especially from the hostels which are killing hundreds of his subjects. He also called for swift justice to the heinous acts of the killing of izinduna and amakhosi. He also called for unity among churches. The decried corruption in the public service saying it was a cancer eating to the core of his people's needs.

The King also reiterated his commitment to the Ingonyama Trust saying he was not about to betray the nation, the royal household and the throne entrusted in him by his subjects and God. He said he was the custodian of the land and as such he was committed to preserving it like his father King Zwelithini kaBhekuzulu did. The King urged the churches and his subjects to also pray for "the Zulu Prime Minister" [Inkosi Mangosuthu Buthelezi] saying his leadership was still needed like his father before him draw support from the Zulu Prime Minister.



The King said his dream was to build a Palace, a church and a tourist attraction epicentre at the site in which King Dinuzulu once lived. He said other races who heard about the prayer have called him asking why they had been been excluded and he promised that the place will be inclusive to all those who are part of the Zulu history.
